The message of the event is “Stay in school, graduate, and opportunities are in your future!” The Seneca County Partners for Youth, Children, and Families County-wide Collaboration is sponsoring the event which will be held at Hillside Children’s Center Varick Campus Gymnasium on Friday April 24, 2009 from 9:30 am to 2:30 pm. The target audience are Freshmen and Sophomores from Seneca County high schools.

Dede Olufsen, a member of the planning committee, explained why the Partners are holding the fair. “Concern over early career planning opportunities and high school dropout rates prompted the concept of the Job/Career Fair.
